HOSPICE IN YOUR CARE HOME



What can we offer?

- Support Care Home staff to understand the principles of palliative and end of life care so they can integrate these into their everyday routine.
- Deliver education and training through small group teaching sessions or working with Care Home staff on a one-to-one basis.
- Work with the Care Home to establish their residents' preferences and wishes and develop a plan to achieve these (known as Advance Care Planning). This might include talking to GPs, hospital teams and other professionals to ensure all those involved in their care understand the resident's wishes for their end of life care.
- Additional support for those important to the person who is dying.

Who is in charge of the resident's care?


The Care Home will still have overall responsibility for the care delivered. The Hospice in your Care Home team will work alongside the staff to provide specific education and support.

Is there a charge for this service?

The Hospice is a registered charity, largely supported by voluntary funding, and all our services are provided at no cost to our service users.

When are we available?

The team will work Monday to Friday between the hours of 9am and 5pm although there is some flexibility with these times if a specific need is identified.

With the appropriate support and education, Care Home staff can continue to provide care which respects your wishes and/or the wishes of those important to you.

The **Hospice in your Care Home** team will work together in partnership with Care Homes to enhance the care of residents in the last few weeks and days of life with the aim of promoting comfort and dignity.

Hospice in your Care Home is a new service offered by Wigan and Leigh Hospice and will initially be available in 8 nursing homes.

It is hoped that the team will extend its service to all nursing homes across the borough in the future.
